

Safe Tweaks Checklist for Windows 11

Use this checklist to safely optimize Windows 11 performance, reduce RAM usage, and improve startup speed without risking system stability.

Startup Optimization

- ■ Disable unnecessary startup apps from Task Manager.
- ■ Keep antivirus and graphics drivers enabled at startup.
- ■ Remove unused cloud sync tools from startup.
- ■ Restart your PC after major startup changes.

RAM & Performance Tweaks

- ■ Close background apps you don't use regularly.
- ■ Disable visual effects for better performance.
- ■ Enable Storage Sense to free temporary files.
- ■ Keep at least 20% free space on the system drive.
- ■ Use lightweight browsers when multitasking.

Safe System Maintenance

- ■ Run Windows Update regularly.
- ■ Update GPU, chipset, and audio drivers.
- ■ Scan for malware using Windows Security.
- ■ Create a restore point before advanced tweaks.
- ■ Uninstall software you no longer use.

Browser & App Optimization

- ■ Limit excessive browser tabs.
- ■ Remove unnecessary browser extensions.
- ■ Disable apps running in the background.
- ■ Use web apps instead of heavy desktop apps when possible.

Advanced but Safe Tweaks

- ■ Set Power Mode to Best Performance when plugged in.

- ■ Disable transparency effects.
 - ■ Turn off unnecessary widgets and animations.
 - ■ Use Task Manager to monitor high RAM processes.
 - ■ Check disk health periodically.

Tip: Always test one tweak at a time so you can easily identify changes that improve or reduce performance.
